The Award

Every year, SOGESCI-B.V.W.B., the Belgian OR-society, organizes a student competition funded by OM Partners.

The Orbel Award (worth €1000) is bestowed on the author(s) of a scientifically oriented student's thesis with the exception of PhD theses. The criteria for judgement are based on the efficiency and effectivity of the scientific approach applied to solve the problem under study. The author(s) should put emphasis on the application of existing methods in new areas or on the application of new solution methods for models recognised as useful for solving real-life management problems. One of the criteria will be, therefore, the actual collaboration with industry during the thesis elaboration.

The paper can be written in Dutch, French or English. It will be assessed by a jury mainly taking into account the effectiveness of the theoretical methods to solve practical problems.

SOGESCI-B.V.W.B. is the Belgian Society for the promotion of scientific methods of management.
